Mandatory Use of National Identification Card for Vehicle Registration, Renewal, and Driver's License Processing

The Ministry of Transport wishes to inform the public that in line with **Executive Order No. 147**, issued by His Excellency President **Joseph Nyuma Boakai, Sr.**, all Citizens and Residents of Liberia are **required to enroll and obtain the National Biometric Identification Card (NBIC)** to access public and private services, including those offered by the Ministry of Transport.


Effective **June 1, 2025**, all individuals seeking to:

- Register or Renew a **Vehicle Registration**
- Apply for or Renew a **Driver's License**

Must present a valid National Identification Card issued by the **National Identification Registry (NIR)**.

To ensure smooth service delivery at the Ministry of Transport and avoid further complications, all Taxpayers must complete their enrollment and obtain their **National Biometric Identification Card** on or before **June 1, 2025**. Failure to present the National Biometric Identification Card (NBIC) at the time of service will result in the denial of processing.

The Ministry appreciates your cooperation in improving its service delivery through digital identity integration and National Reform efforts.
